

Admission Requirements, Scholarships & Financial Documentation Guide

Intakes: July & November 2026 | Prepared for Counsellor & Student Reference

This document consolidates the latest entry requirements, available scholarships, gap and marriage case policies, and the updated GS (Genuine Student) financial documentation requirements. Please review carefully before lodging an application.

1. Entry Requirements

1.1 Undergraduate (UG)

Criteria	Requirement
Academic	3.2 CGPA (equivalent to 75% or above)
IELTS	6.5 overall, with no band less than 6.0
PTE	58 overall, with no communicative skill below 50
Backlogs	No backlogs accepted for UG

Preferred UG Profile

- CGPA of 3.2 or higher (75%+)
- IELTS: 6.5 overall / 6.0 in each band
- PTE: 58 overall / 50 in each band

1.2 Postgraduate (PG)

Criteria	Requirement
Academic	Completed Bachelor's degree (AQF Level 7 equivalent — minimum 4 years)
IELTS (Standard PG)	6.5 overall / 6.0 in each band
PTE (Standard PG)	58 overall / 50 in each band
IELTS — MSW (PQ)	7.0 overall / 7.0 in each band
PTE — MSW (PQ)	65 overall
English — Pathways MSW	IELTS 6.5 overall / 6.0 in each band
Backlogs	8–10 backlogs accepted for PG

2. Scholarships

Scholarship	Value	Eligibility
International Student Support	10%	Available to all students holding an offer letter.
Merit-Based Scholarship	25%	Minimum 3.2 GPA in UG (or above); UG: 75%+, PG: 65%+.
New Course Launch Scholarship	35%	Must hold an offer letter for the MSW course — July or November 2026 intake only. Students who defer to 2027 intakes will NOT be eligible.
Vice Chancellor International Scholarship	50%	Requires 80% or GPA equivalent (UG or PG), a valid CSU offer letter, a formal application, written justification, and a 500-word leadership essay.

3. Gap Policy & Marriage Case Requirements

3.1 Gap Acceptance

Level	Acceptable Gap
Undergraduate	Within 9 months of the most recent qualification (Grade 12 or Diploma).
Postgraduate	Within 9 months of the latest academic qualification OR the most recent work experience letter.

3.2 Marriage Case

- Spouse must hold an equivalent qualification.
- The marriage must be at least 1 year old at the time of application.

4. New GS (Genuine Student) Financial Requirements

The minimum income threshold is NPR 25 lakhs per annum. Incomes cannot be combined across sponsors — each individual sponsor must independently meet the required amount.

4.1 Eligible Sponsors

- Parents — either father OR mother must show NPR 25 lakhs (single income).
- Siblings — a single brother OR single sister must show NPR 25 lakhs individually.
- Grandparents — must show NPR 25 lakhs in their own name.
- Spouse — may sponsor up to 50%; the remaining 50% must come from a single primary sponsor (no secondary income allowed).
- The student themselves may sponsor if they own a business demonstrating a minimum of NPR 25 lakhs in income.

- Foreign income is accepted.

4.2 Income Source Rules

Source	Acceptance Rule
Agricultural Income	NOT accepted.
Vehicle Income	NOT accepted.
Tax Clearance	2-3 years of tax clearance required.
Bank Statement	6 months of statement required.
Rental Income (Residential)	Accepted up to 40% of total income.
Commercial Rental Income	Accepted with a 12-month bank statement.
Business Income	Accepted with 6-12 months of bank statements.
Bank Class for Income Statements	Accepted from A, B, and C class banks.

4.3 Educational Loan & Savings

- Educational loans are accepted from all banks EXCEPT Prabhu Bank.
- Educational loans may be taken from in-laws, provided the in-laws are not travelling.
- Savings are accepted if the funds are matured for 6 months and frozen for the last 6 months.
- Fixed Deposits (FDs) are accepted with a valid source of deposit and must be at least 1 year old.
- Savings from B-class banks are accepted, provided the funds are frozen for the last 6 months.
- Provident Fund is NOT accepted.
- Additional funds of NPR 10-15 lakhs over and above the minimum strengthen the application.

4.4 Indicative Loan Amounts

Course Level	Recommended Educational Loan
Undergraduate (UG)	NPR 65 – 70 lakhs
Postgraduate (PG)	NPR 75 – 80 lakhs
Postgraduate with Dependent	NPR 1.10 crore
