Document submission

- Please upload all required documents at the time of application submission to avoid delays. We recommend submitting each document as a separate, clearly named file rather than combining multiple documents into a single file.
- Submit clear colour photos of original qualifications **without lamination** to help reduce the level of verification required.
- Please encourage applicants to ensure that:
 - All four corners of the document are visible
 - Text is clear and readable
 - Images are in colour
 - Screenshots or cropped images are avoided

Admissions Documentation

- **Application Form**
- **Personal Statement** (minimum 400 words)
- **Passport** (minimum 6 months validity)
- **English Evidence**
- **Qualification** (clear colour photos of the final certificate and transcripts with all 4 corners visible)
 - **Provisional certificate** – if issued within the past 6 months they must also provide a **course completion letter**
- **Translation** (required for non-Latin alphabet)

Admissions Documentation (continued)

- Up to date CV (please ask us for a **CV template**)
- Work reference letter subject to the requirements of the course
 - Issued within the past 6 months, should clearly state job title, length of employment and key responsibilities.
 - Letters from free email accounts or from companies without an active website will be reviewed holistically and may require additional verification or supporting evidence.

MBA programme

- UG degree in a **relevant** subject.
- CV outlining **two years** appropriate work experience.
- Work reference covering two years **IF** the degree is in a **non-relevant subject**.
- Recent graduates with no work experience are **not eligible** for the programme.

MSc programmes excluding Psychology

- UG degree in a **relevant** subject. For **MSc International Management**, we can accept a broader range of academic subjects.
- CV outlining **appropriate** work experience (no specific duration required).
- Recent graduates can be considered with **no work experience** as long as their degree is in a relevant subject (except for **MSc International Management** applicants as stated above).

Verification

- To avoid delays, **the QC consent form** should be uploaded to the candidate's file at an early stage.
- Qualification, MOI, and work reference verifications may be requested at any stage of the application process, including during the Credibility Interview, Admissions review, or CAS stage.
- QC verification takes 2 weeks on average depending on the institution.
- MOI verification can take up to 4 weeks depending on the institution.
- Clear colour photos of original qualifications and MOI can help reduce the level of verification required.



English updates

- **Duolingo** and **Pearson Versant** will no longer be accepted.
- English language evidence must be completed within **7 years of the proposed start date**.
- Some tests are only valid for a certain period e.g. IELTS, TOEFL, PTE, etc.

MOI letter requirements

- Bachelor's degree **completed within the past 7 years**. Based on the date of the final exams, **not** the award date as there can be delays. PG qualifications are **not accepted**.
- We **can accept** UG degrees completed via distance learning.
- The document must be issued on official institutional letterhead and signed by an authorised official, this can be principals, directors, registrar, deputy registrar, controller of examinations, etc.
- The entire course must be taught and assessed in English. We accept standard letters confirming that the Medium of Instruction for this course was English. Modules for a language subject can be accepted but this must be clearly stated in the MOI letter.

Example: If an **IELTS score of 6.0 overall and 5.5** in each component is required, the student must have achieved an **overall band of 6 and 5 in each component** for the **Oxford ELLT**

Change of Course

- Applicants requesting a change of course must complete the Change of Course form:

Change of Course before Enrolment

- A new Credibility Interview is required if they are switching subjects (e.g. MBA to Software Engineering).
- Please ensure the following criteria is also met:
 - Updated personal statement reflecting the new course
 - English language for the new course (if applicable)
 - Relevant degree subject/work experience where applicable

General Entry Criteria

- Please be aware that for Level 4 entry, a **specific grade(s)** is usually required.
- For Level 6 Top-Up: Level 5 qualification in a **relevant subject** e.g. HND, DipHE or Foundation Degree.
- In cases where alternative qualifications are provided and you are unsure, please check with Admissions to confirm eligibility.



MSc Psychology

- 2:1 honours degree or above in Psychology with GBR or BPS accreditation.
- 2:2 honours degree in Psychology and successful academic ISM with programme leader.
- Alternative but related degree (e.g. nursing or health and social care) are required to provide a relevant portfolio of work and attend an academic ISM with the programme leader.
- Please note, this course does not confer Graduate Basis for Registration (GBR) with the British Psychological Society (BPS). If seeking to achieve GBP, please refer to the MSc Psychology (Conversion) programme, which will be available in September 2027.

LLM International Business Law

- UG degree in a **relevant** subject.
- CV outlining **appropriate** work experience (no specific duration required).
- IELTS 7.0 or equivalent with no band less than 6.5.
- MOI will **not** be accepted for the LLM as a specific standard of English is required for the course.



Centres

- Applicants with qualifications from a Centre must be reviewed by Admissions to determine whether the institution is recognised.
- If in doubt, please refer to the list of Centers that are not approved, as well as awarding bodies that are accepted and not accepted by our partners.
- Where a Centre is not listed, Admissions will undertake the necessary checks prior to acceptance.
