1. International Foundation Programme (Joint CAS)

Tuition Fee	£16,020
Scholarship	Automatic £2,000 each year
Academic Requirement	Higher Secondary School Certificate (Year 12) with aggregate score of 40% or GPA of 2.0 or above.
Maths (Level 2, if required)	60%/2.8/B in Grade X Mathematics. If applicant has provided Grade XII, 50%/2.4/C+ in Maths or above accepted, or if they don't meet Grade X requirements. Applicants with 50%/2.4/C+ in Grade X Maths can be accepted for International Foundation Programmes. Grade 12 Accounting accepted if Maths not taken for Business-related subjects. Economics is not acceptable.

Academic Requirement	Higher Secondary School Certificate (Year 12) with aggregate score of 50% or GPA of 2.4 or above.
Maths (Level 2, if required)	60%/2.8/B in Grade X Mathematics. If applicant has provided Grade XII, 50%/2.4/C+ in Maths or above accepted, or if they don't meet Grade X requirements. Applicants with 50%/2.4/C+ in Grade X Maths accepted for International Foundation Programmes. Grade 12 Accounting accepted if Maths not taken for Business-related subjects. Economics is not acceptable.

Study Gap Allowed	Up to 10 years (with proper clarification of the study gap)

4. Pre-Master's English & Research Skills (Joint CAS)

Duration	1 Semester
Intake	April/May / January
Tuition Fee	£11,370
Scholarship	Automatic £1,000
Academic Requirement	Students who have met the academic requirements and other pre-requisites for direct entry to their desired Masters course but haven't met the English language requirements can apply for this Pre-Masters course.
English Requirement	IELTS 5.5 overall (no module < 5.5) OR PTE 59 overall (no module < 59)
Study Gap Allowed	Up to 10 years (with proper clarification of the study gap)
Deposit	£300 for P-CAS interview; remaining deposit (per offer letter) to be paid before CAS
Funds to show for visa	50% of Masters tuition fees + Living expenses of £13,761

Common Notes (Across All Programmes)

- All programmes are issued under **Joint CAS**.
- £300 deposit required for P-CAS interview. After passing the final CAS interview, the remaining deposit (as mentioned on the offer letter) must be paid before CAS.
- Living expenses figure of **£13,761** applies across all programmes for visa fund-showing purposes.

- Study gaps require proper clarification/documentation.
- MOI (Medium of Instruction) letters must be issued on university letterhead with an official stamp.
