- 3-day classes in a week, all courses have internships WILs
- Wollongong 85km away from Sydney
- Liverpool and Sydney campuses are non-regional
- Wollongong is regional (all programs available there)

Academic Requirements:

1. For UG programs:- In NEB (Year 12) requires **3.0 out of 4.0 CGPA** minimum and **3.4 out of 4.0 CGPA** for program wise

In PCL/Diploma requires **73%** minimum (Group 1) and **80% (Group 2) to 85% (Group 3)** for program wise

For Diploma leading to Bachelor – 2.5 out of 4 CGPA

Grade Improvement acceptable, but no backlogs

PTE 54 no less than 54

2. For PG Programs:- **50 %** required in Bachelor degree (**for Engineering programs 60%**)

For graduate certificate (1st sem) leading to Masters (3 sems), student needs to just pass

Only **10 backlogs accepted** (Extended one year in academic period can be accepted but need to provide College/University explanation letter)

3-year Bachelors accepted

No gap limit as long as justifiable by work

PTE 62 no less than 54




Double Masters acceptable, but not in the same course

For MBA Advanced course, applicant must have at least 3 years work experience




Two masters in 2 years for freshers available, instead of MBA Advanced

Scholarships:


1. For UG Programs:

- 20%  just need to meet the requirement
- 20-20% for **Diploma leading Bachelor program**  just need to meet the requirement
- 30 % for **Bachelor Programs** if the applicant score  **3.4 CGPA in NEB or 85% in PCL/Diploma**

2. For PG Programs:

- 20%  just need to meet the requirement
- 30 %  need to score **75% in academic**
- 20-20% for **Graduate Certificate leading to Master's programs**  just need to meet the requirement

Refusal case:

1. **Australia refusal**  in case of more than **3-4 years old** can be considered case by case (**below 3 years is not accepted**), **must be justified**
2. **USA, Canada, New Zealand, UK refusal, even recent ones** can be considered, must be justified
3. In case of **Spouse visa refusal** for any country then Dual travel (Dependent apply) is not accepted (Need to apply for Single travel)

Offer documents Checklist:

1. Passport (Stamp page required if the applicant has travel in any other countries)
2. Academic from Grade 10 to latest qualification (Transcript, Character, Provisional & Migration certificate)
3. Equivalence letter if abroad degree
4. CV compulsory (mention proper start and end date on education and experience or gap history)
5. GS Screening form (attached)
6. GS Checklist (attached)
7. Applicant Declaration Form (attached)
8. Marriage Registration Certificate (if married)
9. Birth certificate of child (if there is child)

For Dependent Apply:

1. Spouse's Passport, Academic, Gap details (if there is gap)
2. Spouse's academic need to be minimum Bachelor Degree passout
3. Marriage Date need to be 1 year old

Spouse can sponsor if not accompanying, upto 30%

GS Requirements:

1. Annual Income:




- **21 lakhs** and above for **Single**
- **24-25 lakhs** and above for **Married**

2. Funds:

- **65 lakhs** and above for **Single**

- **70-75 lakhs** and above for **Married**
- If funded through **Loan**, Additional **40% to 60% of loan amount** as additional funds required
- Regarding FD :- No need to break but requires FD Statement minimum 6 months
- In case of renewal in FD (requires FD receipt)
- In case of Balance (requires minimum 6 months of Bank Statement)

3. Supporting Financial Documents:

- **In Business Income**  Requires **One (1) Year Bank Statement** and **Three (3) years Tax Clearance**
- **Other Incomes**  Requires **Six (6) Months Bank Statement** and **Two (2) years Tax Clearance**
- **Vehicle income**  can be consider only case by case, but must be very strong

Point to be noted:

1. Only **2 sponsors** are accepted [i.e. One (1) Parents and additional One (1) secondary]
2. *Father* and *Mother (Inlaws and Grandparents as well)* are counted as One (1) sponsor
3. Parents and Parents-in-Laws are counted as **Primary Sponsors**
4. Grandparents and Siblings are counted as **Secondary Sponsors**
5. **70 % primary and 30% secondary**
6. **No specific annual income ratio, but should be diversified. No total rental income, it must be combined with other sources**
7. Proof of verification of documents is needed
